Nathan & Joe




Dear Birthmother,

Joe's work as a Pediatrician and Nathan's extremely close relationships with his siblings led us early on to realize that having children was very important to both of us.










NATHAN

JOE



I love my career as a pediatrician and have a passion for child health advocacy. I devote a good portion of my free time to advocating for policies that support the health of the youth in our communities.


